Delay in BOAQ Registration Renewals 2020/21 year

Please note that as a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and in consultation with the Queensland Government, the Board of Architects of Queensland (BOAQ) is delaying the open of its 2020/21 Queensland architect registration renewal period by a few weeks.

Usually, BOAQ sends out renewal notices via email on 1 April. We are now expecting this open date to be closer to May this year.

Once we have opened renewals, Application for Renewal Forms will be emailed to all registered Queensland architects, and you will be able to renew online, or by mail, as usual. N.B. The office is closed to visitors.

Your current registration remains in effect through to 30 June 2020.
